Student Council Corner

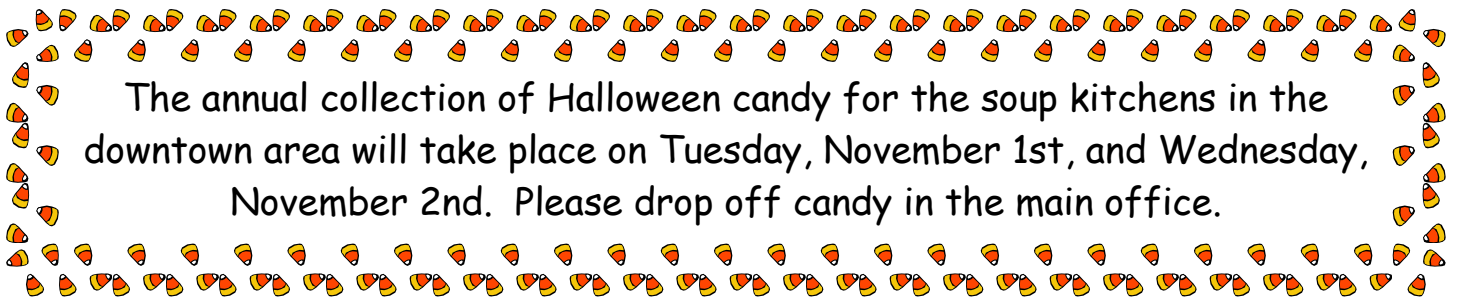

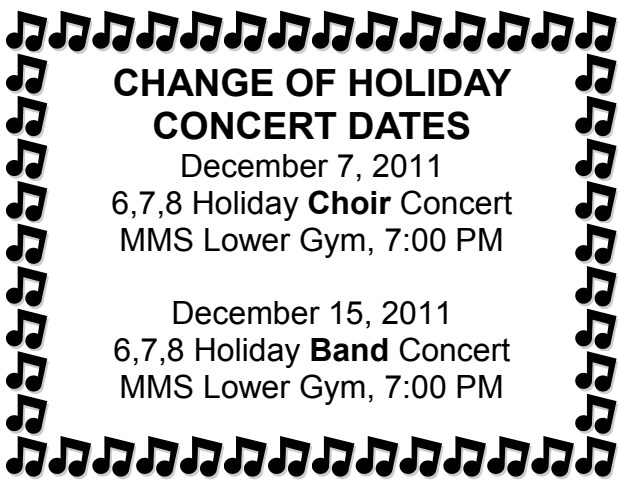

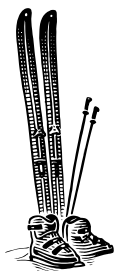
